izredni profesor na Fakulteti za varnostne vede Univerze v Mariboru in višji znanstveni sodelavec na Pravnem inštitutu Znanstveno-raziskovalnega središča Koper.

Dogodek bo potekal

**v palači Tiepolo-Gravisi, Kreljeva 6 Koper,
v sredo, 19. marca 2025, s pričetkom ob 11 uri.**

Profesor dr. Miro Cerar je dekan Pravne Fakultete Univerze v Ljubljani in nekdanji predsednik Vlade Republike Slovenije. Po študiju prava se je zaposlil na ljubljanski Pravni fakulteti. Konec 80-ih let prejšnjega stoletja se je aktivno vključil v prizadevanja za demokratizacijo in državno osamosvojitve Slovenije. Sodeloval je pri pisanju Temeljne ustavne listine o samostojnosti in neodvisnosti in Ustave Republike Slovenije. Leta 2008 je kot Fulbrightov štipendist šest mesecev poučeval primerjalno ustavno pravo na Golden Gate University School of Law v San Franciscu in se postdoktorsko študijsko izpopolnjeval na University of California School of Law v Berkeleyju. Pred vstopom v politiko (2014) je bil zunanji svetovalec Državnega zbora za ustavna in druga pravna vprašanja. Dr. Cerar se kot pravnik in intelektualec zavzema za vladavino prava, ustavno demokracijo in dvig pravne kulture. Uporabniki portala Tax-Fin-Lex so ga štirikrat (2011-2014) izbrali za najvplivnejšega slovenskega pravnega strokovnjaka.

Gost in moderator bosta razpravljala o strukturnih značilnostih EU in problematiki zagotavljanja (diferencirane) enakopravnosti članic.

Professor Dr Miro Cerar is the Dean of the Faculty of Law at the University of Ljubljana and a former Prime Minister of the Republic of Slovenia. After studying law, he began his academic career at the Faculty of Law in Ljubljana. In the late 1980s, he became actively involved in efforts to democratize Slovenia and achieve its independence. He contributed to drafting the Fundamental Constitutional Charter on Sovereignty and Independence and the Constitution of the Republic of Slovenia. In 2008, as a Fulbright scholar, he taught comparative constitutional law for six months at Golden Gate University School of Law in San Francisco and completed his postdoctoral studies at the University of California, Berkeley, School of Law. Before entering politics in 2014, he served as an external advisor to the National Assembly on constitutional and other legal matters. As a legal expert and intellectual, Dr Cerar advocates for the rule of law, constitutional democracy, and the advancement of legal culture. Users of the Tax-Fin-Lex portal named him the most influential Slovenian legal expert four times (2011–2014).

The guest and the moderator will discuss the structural characteristics of the EU and the challenges of ensuring (differentiated) equality among its Member States.
